






# WeBSET


 A data driven system that provides automatic generation of state specific IEP format, forms, and evaluation.

 Automatically integrates IEP information directly into the state report forms. All state specific state codes are integrated throughout the system.


 WeBSET is continuously update for state compliance changes following state verification.


 Student Event Manager provides Case Managers, Process Coordinators, and Directors with a powerful on-line “Event” query system. IEP meetings, triennial, evaluation, and all other events (dates) can be queried and printed for review.


 Provides a unique centralized monitoring system which allows the Special Education Director to review all exceptions on all IEP information for every student throughout the entire district. This feature is also available for process coordinators and case managers.


 WeBSET is an entirely web-based system, thus allowing secure access from any location with Internet connectivity. Even dial up Internet access provides users with a great user experience.


 Allows users to utilize Windows, Macintosh, and Linux workstations. All that is required is a browser.

 Features a unique Goal Bank. Appropriate district personnel may add to their goal bank. Districts may also elect to *allow staff the ability to “override” the system goals with their own goals* on an IEP.


 Has an *Evaluation Summary System* that features a unique *Forms Builder* application. This allows the district to create their own Evaluation Summary Report including their own district logo, headings, selected data to be inserted in the document, and more.


 The *Child Count Report* is *generated in seconds*, and provides a unique *error log* that assists the district in correcting and verifying their report.

 Features a unique *Report Builder System* that allows districts to create their own ad hoc reports.

 Allows multiple users to access the same student's information simultaneously through its unique record locking capabilities, without loss of information. This also allows directors, process coordinators, and case managers to collaboratively work on the same IEP.

 Provides on-line help text and walk through “Flash” training modules. Users are able to experience the various features and their functionality.

 System Announcements provide all users notification of state compliance updates and system enhancements.

 HIPAA compliant features include unattended system logout, data update journalling, user login access journalling and user application access journalling
